

Spelling Words

Vowel Sounds in tooth and cook

Generalization The vowel sound in *tooth* can be spelled **oo**, **ew**, **ue**, and ui: school, few, glue, fruit. The vowel sound in *cook* can be spelled oo and u: cookie, cushion.
